
### Installation Steps



Yo! Here we go! Your Studly Bracket is designed to be installed directly onto wall studs. See **Rad Tip** ① on page 7 for more information. Position your bracket on a stud or post, then install a wall fastener into an upper fastener hole location.




Straighten your bracket using a level. Mark a lower fastener hole location with a fastener tip or a pencil. Install a second wall fastener into this location, then recheck for level.




Install the remaining fasteners into remaining fastener holes. Your first Studly bracket is installed! Crack open and take a swig of your favorite non-alcholic brew.

If you are installing multiple brackets to support a shelf slab, continue on to the rest of the steps. If not, skip to step 6.



To mount additional brackets aligned with the first, use a level to align both brackets and **repeat steps 1–3** with the second bracket. See **Rad Tip** ② and ③.



Position shelf slab between tabs on top bracket surface. See **Rad Tip** <sup>®</sup> on page 7 for shelf surface recommendations.



Drill a pilot hole through shelf slab into the stud at a 45° angle. Install set screws through shelf into stud to lock slab into position. You are done. Stand back, finish off your soda, and shout "Stout, Sturdy, Studly!"

### **Rad Tips**











1.1 Studly brackets are designed to be mounted on a fixed stud, post, or other structural surface. Drywall is not structural, and will not support this bracket.



2.1 You can turn a short level into a long one by laying it on a straight object like a yard stick. Just hold it on the wall with your bullet level on top and measure!



3.1 Bracket spacing is up to you. It's part of Studly's insanely cool aesthetic. With that said, these brackets should never be more than 48" apart. Saggy shelves suck!



4.1 To accomodate a full 8, 12, or 16 inch deep slab, be sure the front surface of the verticle mounting segment is flush with the stud or post.
