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





### Installation Steps



Woah! That's a wicked Wave Picture Ledge you have there! Position picture ledge on the wall with the pre-drilled holes along the top edge. Using a stud finder, align fastener holes with as many studs as possible. Use drill to fasten matching 1½" fastener in either far left or




Level the picture ledge and set second matching 1½" fastener in opposite end fastener hole with your drill. If the fastener holes miss an available stud, see Rad Tip ① on page 7. If you've already installed blocking behind the length of the backbar, skip to Step 5.




While the picture ledge is mounted to the wall, mark every remaining empty fastener hole with a pencil.




Remove the picture ledge from the wall to install wall anchors in each marked location that is not on a wall stud. Predrill each wall anchor location with ¼" drill bit to avoid breaking wall anchors.



Replace the picture ledge. Drill matching 1½" fastener into each fastener hole.



Make final inspection of the picture ledge. Check for picture ledge sag, confirm the picture ledge is correctly secured to wall. If your picture ledge is sagging, refer to Rad Tip ① and ②.



Stand back and relax, you did it! Give your cat a celebratory fist bump, if present. Gently place your Kenny G vinyl collection on picture ledge and admire! If you need more help, please reach out to a shelf geek today.

Fasten Into
All Studs
& Blocking
The Bracket
Crosses





1.1 Studs are the vertical 2x4 boards that make up the bones of your walls. They provide solid structure for your picture ledge to attach to.



2.1 If your wall is not straight, use shims to ensure your picture ledge is installed straight across the wall face and square to the wall.



1.2 Blocking is typically added later between studs in the wall for additional support to mount picture ledges to, and is usually made from 2x4 or 2x6 lumber.
