





Installation Steps



Let's go! First things first, make sure you have sufficient space for your Peek Cabinet Pulls. Ensure that there is at least 5/22" gap between cabinet doors where any adjacent pulls will be located.




Use your totally rad sense of design to find the best location for your Peek Cabinet Pulls. If you are not sure, the illustration here shows suggested configurations. See Rad Tip ① on page 7 for additional help.




If you are using Peek Cabinet Pulls as drawer pulls, here are some suggested configurations. Otherwise, skip to Step 4.







Position cabinet pull in desired location, hold in place and mark fastener holes with a pencil or fastener tip.



Drill a small pilot hole in the center of your mark with a #44 (.086") or smaller drill. To avoid accidental drill through, keep the pilot hole shallow. See Rad Tip @ on page 7.



Reposition your cabinet pull, and install cabinet fasteners with a phillips head screw driver.



Stand back and relax, you did it! Give your cat a celebratory fist bump, if present.



Rad Tips

① Flush Mount Your Cabinet Pull

②Avoid DrillingToo Deeply



1.1 To flush-mount your cabinet pull, place a level or a straight edge along the side of the door. Slide the cabinet pull into place until it touches the level. Hold in place and mark the screw hole locations.



2.1 To avoid drilling too deeply, measure the thickness of your cabinet door. Wrap a piece of tape around your drill bit to mark a drilling depth at least K." less than the door thickness. Drill just until the tape reaches the surface. It may be helpful to remove the cabinet door to obtain accurate drilling.
