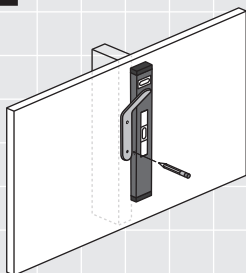
Installation Steps

001



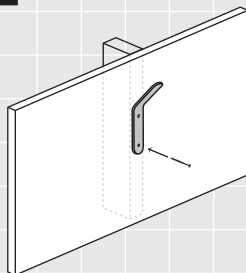
Yo, let's go! Position your Popsicle hook on your wall in the desired location. Align the top fastener hole with wall area backed by a stud or blocking. See **Rad Tip ①** on page 7 for more information on blocking. Use a drill to install one of the included 1½" fasteners into this location. If there is no stud or blocking, skip to step 4.

002



Level the Popsicle hook. Mark the lower fastener hole location with a pencil or fastener tip.

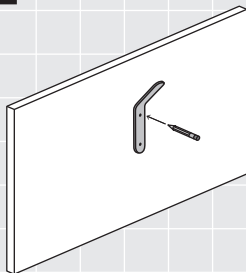

Install second 1½" fastener in lower marked location. If your hook is on studs or blocking, proceed to step 4.

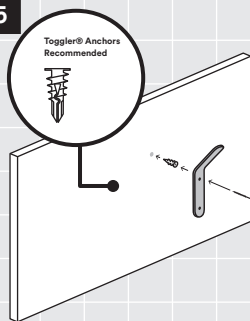

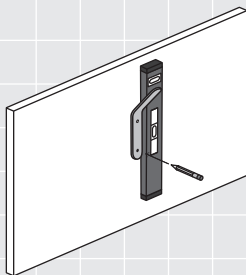
Confirm that your hook is on the wall in the desired location. Mark upper fastener hole with pencil or fastener tip. Predrill marked location with $\frac{1}{4}$ " drill bit, making a pilot hole for a wall anchor.

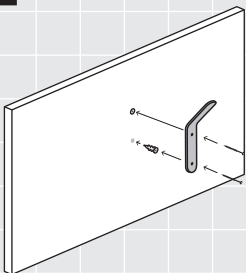
Install a wall anchor into the fastener hole, then install your hook and first $1\frac{1}{2}$ " fastener. Fasten less than full tightness.

006



Level the hook. Mark the second hole with a pencil or fastener tip. Uninstall the first $1\frac{1}{2}$ " fastener and hook. Predrill a second pilot hole with $\frac{1}{4}$ " drill bit.

007



Install the second wall anchor. Install your hook with both matching $1\frac{1}{2}$ " fasteners, then voila! Stand back and relax, you did it! Give your cat a celebratory fist bump, if present. If you need more help, please reach out to a shelf geek today.

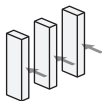

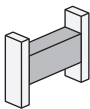

① Fasten Into All Studs & Blocking The Hook Crosses



1.1 Studs are the vertical 2x4 boards that make up the bones of your walls. They provide solid structure for your wall hooks to attach to.

When you install Popsicle correctly, each hook will handily hold up to 50 lbs.



1.2 Blocking is typically added later between studs in the wall for additional support to mount hooks to, and is usually made from 2x4 or 2x6 lumber.
