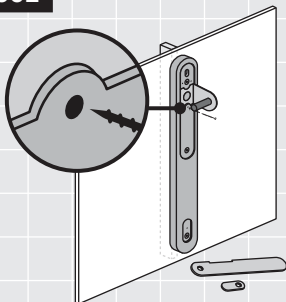

Installation Steps

001

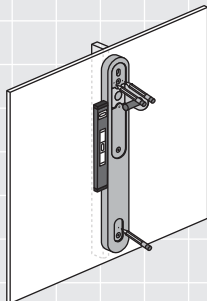


Yo, let's get started! Remove steel cover plates, and set aside. Your Wallride Vertical Bike Hanger features a bracket that can have the hook on either the right or left, so if you would like to switch the side that the hook is on, see **Rad Tip ①** on page 7.

Position your Wallride Vertical Bike Hanger on your wall in the desired location, ideally with center fastener holes aligned on studs or blocking. For more information on studs and blocking, see **Rad Tip ②** on page 7.

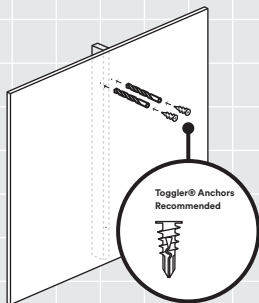
Use a drill to install one of the included truss head fasteners into the center

Use a level to vertically level your hanger. Mark remaining fastener hole locations with a pencil or fastener tip.

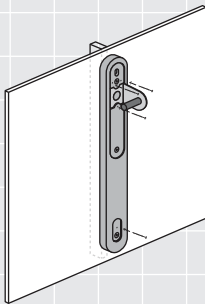


Remove your hanger from the wall. Using a 1/4" drill bit, predrill all fastener locations not on studs or blocking.

Install a wall anchor into all predrilled fastener locations. If you are using your own anchors, we recommend Toggler brand for best results.

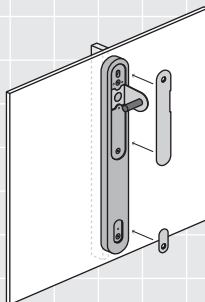

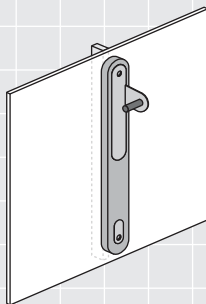
Replace your hanger and make final install of all matching truss head fasteners.

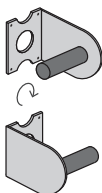

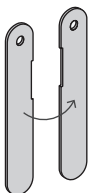
4.1 Powder coated carbon steel does not equal waterproof. If water has direct and constant contact with the hanger, like in a shower or outdoors, it will rust. Hangers installed in these conditions are not covered by our warranty.

① Bracket Orientation



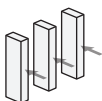
1.1 The orientation of your bracket is entirely up to you and the feng shui of your space.

To change the side the hook is on, simply use a Phillips drill bit to uninstall fasteners, rotate the bracket 180°, then reinstall fasteners to secure bracket into place.

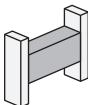


1.2 The cover plate is also reversible—don't forget to flip it so the notch in the side aligns with the bracket.

② Fasten Into All Studs & Blocking The Hanger Crosses



2.1 Studs are the vertical 2x4 boards that make up the bones of your walls. They provide solid structure for your hanger to attach to.



2.2 Blocking is typically added later between studs in the wall for additional support to mount your hanger to, and is usually made from 2x4 or 2x6 lumber.
